JOB DESCRIPTION/JOB ANALYSIS FOR THE POST OF SENIOR VETERINARY OFFICER (BS-18)

Main Responsibilities and Tasks

1. Senior Veterinary Officer (Assistant Director, SPU)

- i. To assist the Deputy Director, in management and administration of SPU.
- ii. To carry out research studies on different aspects of bull management and semen deep freezing.
- iii. Evaluation of each bull on the basis of breeding soundness parameters.

2. Senior Veterinary Officer (Deputy District Officer Livestock (B.I)

- i. Assist the District Officer Livestock in carrying out breed improvement task.
- ii. Monitoring/supervision of A.I. services in the field, performance of field staff at A.I. Centre/Sub-Centre and evaluation parameters of semen and liquid nitrogen supply in the field.
- iii. To carry out Livestock Production Extension programme such as farmer day and to give lecture to farmer for better breeding and to train A.I. Technician for quality maintenance of semen.

3. Senior Veterinary Officer (Incharge Category B A.I. Centre)

Assist the District Officer Livestock in the Divisional Headquarter to vigorously launch the A.I. Service, carry out sexual health control including pregnancy diagnosis among the cows and buffaloes and to carry out Livestock Production Extension programme for introducing better breeding feeding and management.

To monitor the performance of Artificial Insemination Technician and liquid nitrogen and semen storage and utilization.

4. Senior Veterinary Officer (Working in the Directorate Headquarter of Breed Improvement)

To assist the Deputy Director (Hq)/Director in the planning of development projects and in other technical/management issues.
